

Soroptimist Daraja Trip to Kenya

Trip for 4 people

Arrive in Nairobi

Evening arrival. Take in the city while traveling to Africa Heritage House where you will stay the night. Have a light late dinner before bed.

Day 1

Breakfast at the hotel with a tour of Africa Heritage. Debrief on upcoming events before lunch. Visit the Nairobi National Museum and back to the hotel for dinner and bed.

Day 2

Breakfast at the hotel. Depart Nairobi for an incredible drive through Kenya on the way to Nanyuki. Stop on the way for lunch and a coffee farm tour. Check into Daraja that evening and have a special student-led tour before dinner.

Day 3

Daraja sunrise walk (you'll already be awake). Visit a couple classes and debrief with Daraja administration before lunch. After lunch, visit the local primary school and Twala Women's Cooperative. Then back to Daraja to take a tour of Kenyan flora and fauna with resident Daraja expert. Dinner with the girls.

Day 4

Enjoy a morning walk with your new Daraja friends. After breakfast Visit traditional markets in Naibor and Nanyuki, including visit to local artisans. Lunch at Trout Tree Resort. Back to Daraja for a chance to rest before dinner.

Day 5

Learn (or watch) how to milk camels. Join the girls during their student-led spiritual time. Leave campus after tea for brunch at Fairmont Mt Kenya Safari Club. Ol Pejeta Conservancy (famous rhino preserve) and Check into Serena Sweetwaters Resort.

Day 6

A day of relaxation and safari game drives.

Day 7

Breakfast at Sweetwaters then head out for lunch at Lake Nakuru. Spend the evening on a game drive at Lake Nakuru (famous for flamingos).

Day 8

Drive through Naivasha for the Maasai Mara Reserve where there will be a chance for more animal watching. Maasai Mara is situated in the rift valley region (where life began on earth). Just across the Tanzanian border is the Serengeti National Park.

Day 9

A day of relaxation and safari game drives.

Day 10

Final morning game drive followed by a visit to a traditional Maasai village.

Day 11

Depart for Lake Naivasha. Stop for lunch and entertainment at Cafe Ubuntu Maai Mahiu

Spa at Hells Gate Natural Geothermal Spa.

Day 12

Sunrise Yoga for those interested. Breakfast is followed by birding on Crescent Island. Depart for Nairobi and Africa Heritage House.

Day 13

David Sheldrick Elephant Sanctuary and the Giraffe Center. Lunch in Karen, a famous part of Nairobi. Enjoy Kazuri Beads and Kitengela Hot Glass in Karen before heading back for dinner.

Day 14

Time at the Africa Heritage House to prepare for departure.
